












Sternberg Triarchic Theory

 <p data-bbox="578 564 695 596">Practical</p>	<p data-bbox="769 564 896 632">Applying Using</p>	<p data-bbox="1162 550 1500 699">Often required for everyday tasks, which are frequently ill-defined, with multiple solutions</p>
 <p data-bbox="578 804 695 835">Creative</p>	<p data-bbox="769 804 906 871">Inventing Designing</p>	<p data-bbox="1162 804 1471 953">Demonstrated in reacting adaptively to novel situations and generating novel ideas.</p>
